Fr. Oliver O'Doherty 1939-2015

On Monday last, Fr. Oliver O'Doherty was laid to rest in the grounds of the Parish Church in Templederry. It was at the same church in June of 1964 that Oliver celebrated his first Mass. He served the people of the Diocese of Killaloe for 51 years, giving 28 years to teaching on the staff of St. Flannan's College. Fr. Oliver O'Doherty or Ollie as we always affectionately called him: Priest; Athair Ollie, Gaeilgeoir, Muinteor inspioráideach; teacher; mischievous prankster. Teacher is the most appropriate description. Ollie was truly a teacher, not just a much loved classroom teacher but a man who taught so much to those of us who knew him and loved him. He taught us when to be serious and when to have fun, how to love and to be loved, how to enjoy health and how to cope with illness. Above all he taught us how to be fully human and fully
