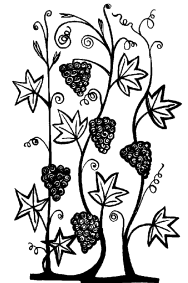

Next month Cultivate Living and Learning will be delivering a course supported by the Clare Local Development Company that will introduce the principles of sustainable development and new approaches to setting up community scale enterprises around food, energy and tourism. The overall objective of this training is to build the capacity of community catalysts to have an impact on the social, economic and environmental aspects of community life in Clare.
