AN ADDITION TO THE WINTER WEEKEND MASS SCHEDULE

A reminder that the winter Mass schedule will take effect from the weekend of **November 6th/7th.** You will notice one short-term addition to our regular winter schedule. Taking on board the public health advice regarding social distancing and the importance of ventilation it would be unwise for us not to use Our Lady of the Rosary Church for our Sunday schedule. The benefit of this building is that it allows for social distancing, and ventilation is less of a problem due to the high ceilings. Such factors keep people safe and instil confidence in those who wish to join us for worship but may have health concerns. With this in mind we are going to maintain the 11.00 Mass on Sunday mornings in Our Lady of the Rosary Church, Newmarket. We will keep this decision under review in line with the most up-to-date public health advise.
