Message of the Holy Father Francis for Lent 2023

In this excerpt of Pope Francis' Lenten Message we see how Pope Francis links the events of the Transfiguration and our current Synodal Journey. "The disciples' experience on Mount Tabor shows the newness of Christ is at the same time the fulfilment of the ancient covenant and promises;.... In a similar way, the synodal journey is rooted in the Church's tradition and at the same time open to newness. Tradition is a source of inspiration for seeking new paths and for avoiding the opposed temptations of immobility and improvised experimentation. The Lenten journey of penance and the journey of the Synod alike have as their goal a transfiguration, both personal and ecclesial. So that this transfiguration may become a reality in us this year, I would like to propose two "paths" to follow in order to ascend the mountain together with Jesus and, with him, to attain the goal. Next week we will read Pope Francis first path."
