### Diocesan Changes

The Diocesan announcement that has most impact on our Parish and on the Tradaree Pastoral Area is that at the end of July Fr. Michael is being moved from Newmarket on Fergus and Tradaree Pastoral area to be VF in *Radharc na nOileán* Pastoral Area and to be resident in Kildysart. Fr. Michael will also continue in his role as Episcopal Vicar for Mission and Ministry for the Diocese. Fr. Michael will be replaced by Fr Albert McDonnell who will take up his appointment in early November following a mini-sabbatical. In the interim the priests of the Tradaree Pastoral Area will take responsibility for Newmarket on Fergus Parish with Fr. Tom Whelan taking on the role of acting VF and contact person for Newmarket on Fergus Parish.
