Family friendly historic walk 8km(5 miles) on Sunday 30th June : Meet at the parish hall 10.00 am. 1834

**1st stop** the treatment plant 2003.

**2nd stop** Famine Village -1845 — Geraldine O'Callaghan

**3rd stop** The Pike Toll Bridge - 1784 — John O'Brien

**4th stop** Ballintlea Rapeseed Mill for oil and soap manufacture - 1640—Lorcan Roche Kelly

Back across the Mill bridge and Mill Lane to Rossmanagher road and Home to the Village

The 1st half of the walk is along the Rossmanagher road to the Pike bridge

The 2nd half is along the bank of the O Garney river. This is a Cow path with fences. Fences have been lowered to allow crossing.
