#### KNOCKADOON — Parish Walk 14th Sept

They brought us along the contours of the hill leading to their fairy fort. They had driven the cattle out in



advance of our arrival. They led us down the hill with care and skill that would compete with that of a sherpa. Be justice to the expertise of the sherpa. We were entertained with a meitheal style tea with cake and sandwiches. Proud of their fort where they used to picnic, To the Henchy family of Clenagh we dedicate this tour and thank them for their hospitality.

A hilltop fort belongs to a class of its own within the fort community. Defended settlements distinguished from hillforts are usually smaller than them but their defensive features are about the same size. Knockadoon hilltop fort is situated on a hill five kilometres south west of Newmarket on Fergus. Its name as

pronounced by locals is Crocadoon using the Connacht dialect word for hill instead of the Cnoc Munster. Dun is the Irish word for a fort, Dúin is the grammatical form for the possessive case. The fort occupies one and a half acres and it is oval shaped 93 m NS, 75m EW. The natives on the tour could point out the houses of their neighbours while everyone else as well as they could identify the bigger landmarks.
