October 12th: the parish walk will take in the life of William Smith O'Brien on the grounds of Dromoland Castle and in the walled garden. Assemble at the Fairgreen, Church Carpark at 11am. As we will be outside, rain wear may be needed.

Depart fair green church car park @ 1.00 pm. Arrive earlier especially if lift required. Cost Circa €20 for 2½ hour guided tour. Refreshments at local pub afterwards.

The full tour is multi-site tour which begins as the Grange Stone Circle. This is the largest and oldest in Ireland and has a rare example of neolithic artwork on one of its stones. The second stop is Teampull Nua (Irish - New Church), a 15th century ruined church on the lakes southern shore. After Teampull Nua you visit the Giant's Grave, a Bronze Age wedge tomb which is over 4,000 years old. Depending on livestock and weather, we sometimes bring guest up to Carraig Geala (Irish - the Bright Rock), where two fine examples of Gaelic-era ringforts are located overlooking the lake. The final stop is at the lakefront, where we also have our visitors' centre as well as a crannóg (man-made island), historical lime kiln. Many would say this is the most tranquil spot in all of Limerick. This tour typically last 2/2.5 hours. There is a base rate of €100 and this covers 1 - 5 people.

6 - 10 people €17 extra per person

The tour begins at the Grange Stone Circle (it does not begin at the lakefront or visitor centre)

Visitors will need a form of transport as we drive between the various sites.
